SCORPO PINOT NOIR 2008

Excellent colour and clarity; an exercise in the simultaneous delivery of purity and power, the red and black plum and cherry fruits intergrated with fine ripe tannins on the long and satisfying palate.

SCORPO CHARDONNAY 2008

Light, bright green...the palate has a superb tactile quality that incites saliva to flow; this citrus component in the spectrum of stone fruit flavours lies at the heart of that tactile quality, for it is sweet, not sour.

'NOIRIEN' PINOT NOIR 2009

Bright crimson-purple; voluminous spiced chery and blood plum on bouquet and palate alike; intended for early consumption but has the structure and fruit to justify a drink some, keep some strategy.

SCORPO SHIRAZ 2007

Bright colour, purple hue; cranberry, bramble and a touch of spice; slightly tart acid profile, but it serves to accentuate the cool nature of wine; long, polished and poised...

SCORPO PINOT GRIS 2009

Has the weight, mouthfeel and structure appropriate for the gris style; ripe spicy pear and stone fruit flavours braced by just enough acidity.

'AUBAINE' CHARDONNAY 2008

Pale colour; a nectarine and stoney, mineral bouquet; the emphasis is on the textural, with vibrant acidity providing a counterpoint to the depth of mid-palate fruit; long and savoury finish.

SCORPO ROSÉ 2009

Pale salmon-pink; a fragrant and spicy bouquet that leads into a crisp, bone-dry savoury palate; positively demands food.
